LEED Credits For New Construction Version 2.2

The U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) is a non profit organization that certifies sustainable businesses, homes, hospitals, schools, and neighborhoods. USGBC is dedicated to expanding green building practices and education, and its LEED® (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Green Building Rating System™.

Quail Run Building Materials is a proud member of the USGBC. Steel framing products contain on average 67% recycled steel. Quail Run Building Materials recognizes the environmental, economic, health and community benefits that come from Green Building.

The LEED for New Construction Rating System is designed to guide and distinguish high-performance commercial and institutional projects, including office buildings, high-rise residential buildings, government buildings, recreational facilities, manufacturing plants and laboratories.

As of January 1, 2006, all LEED for New Construction projects must register under our most current rating system: Version 2.2.

LEED MR Credit 4.1 (1 Point) Recycled Content. Use materials with recycled content such that the sum of the post-consumer recycled content plus one half of the pre-consumer content constitutes at least 10% (based on cost) of the total value of the materials in the project.

LEED MR Credit 4.2 (1 Point in addition to MR Credit 4.1) Recycled Content. Use materials with recycled content such that the sum of the post-consumer recycled content plus one-half of the pre-consumer content constitutes at least 20% of the total value of the materials in the project.

LEED MR Credit 5.1 (1 Point) Regional Materials. Use building materials or products that have been extracted, harvested or recovered, as well as manufactured, within 500 miles of the project site for a minimum of 10% (based on cost) of the total materials value.

LEED MR Credit 5.2 (1 Point in addition to MR Credit 5.1) Regional Materials. Use building materials or products that have been extracted, harvested or recovered, as well as manufactured, within 500 miles of the project site for an additional 10% beyond MR Credit 5.1 (total of 20% based on cost) of the total materials value.
